Important information

Scroll down to find the flights on Thursday 20th March, 2014. The first column shows flights that are landing in Melbourne, where the flight came from (origin) and what time it is expected to land (SToA). The second column shows flights that are leaving Melbourne, where the flight is going to (Destination) and what time it is departing (SToD)

All of the following questions relate to Thursday 20th March. Record the flight number and time in am or pm.

- 1. What time does the earliest flight from Los Angeles arrive at Melbourne Airport? Record the flight number and time of arrival.
- 2. What is the last flight to depart Melbourne Airport?
- 3. What flight departs Melbourne airport at 2:30pm?
- 4. If you are at the airport at 8:30pm which flight is the next to arrive?
- **5.** You arrive at the airport at 10:20am and have 15 minutes to catch your flight. Which flight are you catching?
- 6. What flight arrives at Melbourne Airport at 2:10pm?
- 7. If you miss your 8am flight to Sydney, what is the next flight to Sydney?
- **8 10.** Create 3 of your own 'Teacher style' questions about the Melbourne Airport flights. Find someone in your group, swap questions and answer them.
